

- 1794** 1st feu to Alexander Hannay [24ft].
1812 Passed from Alexander Hanna to ?
1820 Half property sold to William Campbell, tailor in Gatehouse and Jean Campbell, his spouse then Thomas Campbell. Other half to Robert Hannah eldest son of John Hannah.

Campbell's and Hannah's do not appear to be living here between 1841 and 1861.

1852	Sasine of Jessie Campbell or Napier, only child of Thomas Campbell, grocer, deceased. Whole property inherited.
1852	Jessie Campbell or Napier, Kelvingrove Street, Glasgow, wife of John Napier, wholesale tea and fruit merchant , Glasgow sells this and her other Gatehouse properties to Hugh Slimmon, Merchant, Virginia Street, Glasgow.

1859-60 Anwoth Valuation Roll :	No evidence that Hugh Slimmon owned property in Anwoth. Mrs Margaret Campbell, 52 Buccleuth St, Glasgow owned property in Fleet Street that was probably next to no.37 owned by James McTaggart. This property was rented at < £4 p.a.

Sold by Arthur James Hunter, joiner, 51 Bank Street, Dumfries to William Fergusson, subjects last vested in his aunt Katherine Hunter, retired nurse, formerly 15 Fleet Street then 35 Fleet St.
