**1930-31 Anwoth Valuation Roll :** Robert Jardine, draper, owned and occupied the house at Riverside.

**1940-41 Anwoth Valuation Roll :** Alex. G Jardine, 2 Roe Lane, Kingsbury, London, owned Riverside which was occupied by John F B Jardine, draper.

**1950-51 Anwoth Valuation Roll :** Alex. G Jardine owned Riverside which was occupied by John F B Jardine, draper.

**1960-61 Anwoth Valuation Roll :** Alex. G Jardine owned Riverside which was occupied by John F B Jardine, draper. John F B Jardine also owned a garage which he had erected.

**1990** Passed to Thomas Veitch and Gracie Carolyn Jardine or Veitch.
