Angus WYSE snr and Susan McLARTY identified from Angus jnr. birth, marriage and death certificates. We have copies of Angus and Susan's marriage & death certificates. Marriage certificate gives ages and parents names. This leads to Angus snr. birth & baptism ex Neilston OPR. We have never confirmed Susan's birth or baptism. Susan could not write her name on the marriage certificate (in 1869) where her mother's name was Mary THOMSON, but her death certificate (in 1887) gives Janet THOMSON. Angus' parents names were given as George WYSE and Agnes McPHERSON on birth record in OPR and on both marriage and death certificates, yet there is confusion about his age: year of birth in OPR is 1834, age 66 at death suggests born 1836, married age 32 suggests born 1837, age 40 & 53 in 1881 & 1891censuses suggests 1840 & 1837 1881 Barrhead census confirms Jessie to Archibald. 1891 Barrhead census confirms Angus is widower living with George, Agnes, Maggie, Archibald & John.

1891 Barrhead census: Angus jnr, aged 14 was a farm servant living with Samuel and Elizabeth Shearer at Smithyhill Farm, Nei Iston. (per 'Scots ORIGINS').

George, Agnes & Maggie birthdates ex Neilston OPR. John's birth certificate ex May LAIDLAW (daughter of John & Mary WYSE). This is the only reference we have to Angus snr. having McPherson as a middle name. Archibald birth ex census records.

George, Agnes, Archibald and John marriage partners ex May LAIDLAW, also death of John WYSE. We have copy details of Maggie WYSE & Robert NICOL marriage cert. Death of Maggie ex Carolyn NICOL (fam.rec. B7.07), granddaughter of Maggie & Robert WYSE [also Maggie died North Tarrytown & buried Sleepy Hollow, New York State.] George & Jessie marriage ex son Angus' birth certificate. Copy of Jessie's death certificate. Agnes & Maggie middle names from birth records in 'Scots ORIGINS'. Archibald was buried at Neilston Cemetery in 1943, died age 64. We cannot find definite proof of Archibald's middle name (Mc LARTY)









Angus Wyse (jnr) & John Wyse in 1938 (ages 61 & 55)









#### SUSAN McLARTY

Susan's marriage certificate gives her father as Angus McLarty and mother as Mary Thomson. Neither parents were marked as deceased. Her death certificate confirms her fathers name but her mother is given as Janet Thomson. Both parents were deceased.

We have never found a marriage between an Angus McLarty and Mary Thomson and our research suggests that Susan's mother was in fact Janet McTavish. The surname Thomson on the death certificate may have been taken from the marriage certificate. Susan's husband Angus Wyse registered the death. So why did Mary Thomson appear on the marriage certificate?

For those researching the Thomson name in Killean and Kilkenzie, it may be relevant to note that, in this area at least, Thomson was an anglicised form of McTavish Susan could not write when she was married (her mark was witnessed by Angus and Archibald McLarty, possibly 2 of her brothers — or her father and brother) It is possible that Mary Thomson could have been Susan's bridesmaid and a mistake was made on her marriage certificate. There was a Mary Thompson, age 26, living at Lonsdale Bleachfield Womens Lodging House in 1861.

At this time Susan, age 21, was living at Lonsdale Cottage as a domestic servant to David and Henrietta Thompson
We should check on the death certificates of some of Susan's brothers or sisters to see what their mother's name was.

We could not find Susan in the 1851 Lochgilphead census, but Susan and Betty are in the 1851 Paisley (Foxbar) Census living with 102 other girls (all from Argyll), bleaching muslin. Her oldest sisters, Betty and Ann, were each married by ministers of the Free Gaelic Church, which could mean Susan might not have spoken good English (Gaelic being her 1st language) The only Susan McLarty birth between 1838 and 1848 in Scotland was a birth on 08–06–1838 to Malcolm McLarty and Helen Thomson in Port Glasgow. Angus McLarty was born in 1802. (IGI does not give day and month). Angus McLarty married Janet McTavish at Glassary on 19–01–1830 Angus McLarty died 29–05–1878 aged 75, father = Duncan McLarty, mother = Sarah. Duncan McLarty married Sarah McLarty at Killean & Kilchonzie on 19–06–1790
