No father's name was provided on William's marriage certificate. He was aged 28, 38 & 48 in the 1861, 1871 & 1881 censuses implying birth around 1832 in Shackerstone. In 1982, Lewis Davenport examined the Shackerstone baptisms between 1813 and 1840 and found the baptisms of Elizabeth & William to Sarah CLAMP, no fathers name given. We have the text of 2 Shackerstone filiation orders instructing John WEST and Sarah CLAMP to pay weekly amounts to the church for maintenance of Elizabeth and William CLAMP These filiation orders give the birth dates for Elizabeth & William whilst the baptisms came from the OPR. John WEST came from Higham-on-the-Hill. Sarah CLAMP was one of 3 illegitimate children of Elizabeth CLAMP. William BOWN was father to one of these children and could also have been Sarah's father.

1841 Shackerstone census: Sarah's illegitimate children were staying with their grandmother Elizabeth WILSON (née CLAMP), whilst Sarah and Thomas were living in Odstone. In the census Elizabeth & William were given the surname WILSON.

1851 census: Elizabeth CLAMP, jnr aged 30 was still living with her grandmother Elizabeth WILSON. Sarah & Thomas were living with children Anne & Edward. Living at the same address were Elizabeth & William WILSON (still clearly using their grandmother's surname).

1861 Odstone census: William CLAMP aged 28 (Blacksmith, born Shackerstone) with Mary + 3 children.

1871 Odstone census: William CLAMP aged 38 (Engineer & Mechanist (?), born Shackertsone) with Mary + 7 children.

1881 Snarestone census: William CLAMP aged 48 (Machinst, born Shackerstone), with Mary +7 children

1881 Nailstone census: Main Street, Thomas CUTHBERT, widower age 68, blacksmith, born Watton, Herts. + Edward CUTHBERT, blacksmith age 31, born Odstone + his family We have a copy of the will of Thomas CUTHBERT who died 27–07–1885.

If there had been a marriage ceremony between Sarah Clamp and John West, all descendants of William CLAMP would have had the surname WEST!!

He has to pay 1s 6d weekly. Sarah Clamp has to pay 9d weekly "in case she shall not nurse and take care of the said child herself."

"Third year of William the Fourth" (1833) January 9th

Concerning a male bastard child lately born in the parish of Shackerstone of the body of Sarah Clamp on the 13th of November now last past. She charges John West of Higham. He has to pay £1 11s towards maintenance and 1s 6d weekly. Sarah Clamp has to pay 9d weekly "in case she shall not nurse and look after the child herself."
