James WIGHT and Jean NICOL identified ex Jane NICOL (née WIGHT) death certificate. Jane died aged 72 in 1880, which suggests birth between March 1807 and March 1808. All children's christenings ex Scots ORIGINS, but only the father name was given (i.e. James WIGHT), so relevance of all depends on Jean's christening being the correct one Online IGI only gives George WIGHT under children of James WIGHT and Jean NICOL

No evidence of James WIGHT & Jean NICOL marriage. No evidence of them in 1841 per FreeCEN.
