John was 45 in 1841 census and 56 in 1851 census where he is said to have been born in Denby. The above christening date is the only one in Denby within 20 years of 1795. The IGI gives John's father as either Josh or Joshua. The Derbyshire OPR actually records the father as Josh and his marriage to Mary RAYNS confirms his real name as Joseph. We have seen Mary's surname separately transcribed as either RAYNS, BAYNS or RAYNOR. Joseph and Mary's marriage is recorded in the IGI as both RAYNES and BAYNES.

John's siblings are the family of Joseph & Mary Briggs in Denby as recorded in the IGI.

Some IGI references to the marriage of Joseph & Mary also provide their birth dates as 1767 and 1772 respectively, and both were born in Denby.

The Denby batch number P000441 provides no birth / christening for anyone named BAYNS or RAYNOR. There are 8 RAYNS of which 1 was Mary born in 1834

A search for Joseph born in Derbyshire around 1767 yields one in 1762 and one in 1772. We do not know which of these is correct, but the 2 relevant fathers appear to be brothers, so the earlier paternal ancestry should not be affected, but the maternal line is uncertain.

The next 3 records show just why care needs to be taken in believing information that is searchable in the IGI., particularly data that is added later by a member of the LDS Church.

Firstly the transcription errors – Mary Baynes or Mary Raynes, when the actual entry is Mary Rayns. Secondly there is a silly habit of assuming that males are married at 25 years of age, hence a marriage in 1792 for some automatically assumes that the husband would have been born about 1767.

Thirdly the birth date on one has changed from 24 Oct 1772 to 18 Oct 1772.
