There were 14 Thomas Yeomans born in Derbyshire between 1790 and 1800 (per Internet IGI) The Thomas Yeomans jnr. Birth above is the best fit but by no means certain. The parents of the above were given as Thomas and Sarah YEOMANS. Note there are possibly 2 sets of twins.

An Anne Yeomans was christened 21 - 04 - 1797 to Thomas and Sarah but she does not fit in with the above dates, so there may have been 2 Thomas and Sarah Yeoman families.

Bewteen 1772 - 1792, there is only 1 marriage of a Thomas Yeomans to a Sarah in Derbyshire – Thomas Yeomans to Sarah Wagstaff 04 - 08 - 1777 but this seems to be too early to fit with the above family.
