

- James, born in Dalry, about 1800, was married firstly, to Isabella Malcolm, who had been born about 1809. At the time of the 1841 Census they were living at Low Appin, in the parish of Tynron. Isabella died at Knowehead, Carsphairn, on 18th April 1845, aged 35. About 1847, James was married, secondly, to Janet McKie, who had been born at Cubbox, Balmaclellan in July 1815, the daughter of William McKie and his wife Agnes Black. They were at Knowehead, Carsphairn at the times of the 1851, 1861, and 1871 Censuses, where James was described as a farm labourer. James died at Knowehead on 12th June 1874, aged 74. His widow, Janet, was still living at Knowehead at the times of the 1881 and 1891 Censuses, and she died at Bridgend, Carsphairn, on 24th September 1899, aged 84. James had five children from each marriage:
 - a. James, born in Dalry, about 1831, was living, in every Census from 1841 to 1891, with his father, and then with his stepmother. He was described in 1851 as an errand boy, in 1861 as an agricultural labourer, in 1871 as a post runner, in 1881 as a letter carrier (private), imbecile, and in 1891 as a rural letter-carrier, partly imbecile from childhood. James died at Meadowhead, Balmaclellan, on 26th August 1906, aged 75.
 - b. John, born at Lagdon, Glencaim, on 20th April 1835. He was married, in Balmaclellan, on 18th December 1857, to Jane Hunter Baird, who had been born about 1835, the daughter of John Baird, a carter, and his wife, Barbara McRobert. At the time of their marriage, Jane was a housemaid, and John was a ploughman. The family were living at Granitehouse, Carsphairn, at the time of the 1891 Census, where John was a carter. Jane died on 14th December 1898, at which time John was described as a contractor, and John died at Meadowhead, Balmaclellan, on 13th November 1913, described as a retired carter. Their children were:
 - i. James, born in Balmaclellan on 14th May 1858, and married at Strathanna, Carsphairn, on 15th June 1888 to Janet Hastings, who had been born about 1869, the daughter of James Hastings, a shepherd, and his wife Janet Stewart. James died in Carsphairn on 11th February 1940 and Janet died there on 15th November 1950. Their children were:
 - A. Jessie Jane, born in Kells on 25th May 1890, and died unmarried in Dumfries Infirmary on 12th December 1945.
 - B. Mary, born in Carsphairn on 8th October 1891, and married in Carsphairn on 19th December 1919 to John Filshie, described as a farmers assistant from Old Kilpatrick, who had been born on 12th April 1894, the son of James Filshie, a farmer, and his wife Margaret Paton.
 - C. Agnes, born in Carsphairn on 3rd May 1893, and married in Carsphairn on 17th December 1920 to James Symington Ross, who had been born on 7th May 1893, the son of Hugh Ross, a farmer, and his wife Mary Symington.
 - D. James, born in Carsphairn on 10th October 1894, and married in Sanquhar on 21st October 1918 to Maggie Bell Hughes, who had been born on 24th January 1894, the daughter of Elizabeth Hughes.
 - E. John, born in Carsphairn on 16th November 1896 and married in Patna on 14th June 1923 to Agnes Douglas, who had been born on 19th December 1899, the daughter of James Douglas, a coal miner, and his wife Jane Landsborough.
 - F. George, born in Carsphairn on 12th August 1898, and married there on 18th May 1928 to Janet Sykes, who had been born about 1905, the daughter of James Sykes, a shepherd, and his wife Agnes Crosbie.
 - G. Isabella, born in Dalmellington on 1st December 1901, and died a week later on 8th.
 - H. Barbara Baird, born in Dalmellington on 3rd August 1903, and married in Carsphairn on 1st December 1933 to Adam McFadzean, a lorry driver, who had been born about 1906, the son of James McFadzean, a shepherd, and his wife Agnes Gilchrist.
 - I. Susan Isabella, born in Carsphairn on 28th March 1905, and married in Carsphairn on 11th December 1936 to Hugh Cannon, a cotman, of Ross, Borgue, who had been born about 1911, the son of Hugh Cannon, a foreman ploughman, and his wife Sarah Duff.
 - J. Catherine Hastings, born in Carsphaim on 22nd March 1907, and married in Carsphaim on 30th December 1926 to Thomas Allan MacEwan, a gamekeeper, who had been born about 1901, the son of William MacEwan, a foreman surfaceman and his wife Jessie Munro.
 - K. Violet, born in Carsphairn on 19th November 1908, and died there on 24th March 1910
 - L. Jemima, born in Carsphairn on 26th May 1911, and died the following day.

 - B. Jane, born in Carsphairn on 16th August 1892
 - C. Alan, born in Carsphairn on 6th October 1894, and died unmarried in Carsphairn on 14th November 1962.
 - D. Mary Easdale, born Carsphairn on 13th August 1896, and married in Carsphairn on 3rd June 1924 to David Boyle Hewitt who had been born on 13th Apr11 1897, the son of Andrew Niven Hewitt, a gardener, and his wife Jane Boyle.
 - E. Isabella Buck, born in Carsphairn on 11th October 1898 and died there on 4th February 1901.
 - F. John Baird, born in Carsphairn on 12th November 1900.
 - G. George, born in Carsphairn on 31st July 1903

- H, James, born in Carsphairn on 13th February 1906.
- iii. Thomas, born in Carsphairn on 18th July 1862, and married at Craigmark, Dalmellington, on 24th April 1885 to Mary Limond, who had been born about 1863, the daughter of John Umond, a pit enginekeeper, and his wife Mary Logan. Thomas, who was a colliery fireman, died in Holytown on 20th December 1925, and Mary died in Partick on 4th April 1945. Their children were:-
 - A. Mary Logan, born in Dalmellington on 29th March 1885, shortly before her parents' wedding, and married in Glasgow on 12th January 1912, to Hugh Baird, who had been born about 1883, the son of Hugh Baird, an engine fitter, and his wife Mary Crooks.
 - B. John, born in Dalmellington on 15th April 1888
 - C. Thomas, born in Dalmellington on 31st January 1891, and died on 22nd March 1895

At the time of their marriage, Alexander was described as a widower, farmer at Dullox, Glenbucket, and Agnes as a domestic servant. Alexander died in Towie on 2nd July 1896, and Agnes died at Woodpark, Balmaclellan, on 12th November 1919.
- d. Robert, who died in infancy.
- e. Thomas, born at Knowehead on 4th September 1843.
- f. William, born at Knowehead on 3rd February 1848 and baptised on 8th, was married at her father's farm, New Mill, Dalry, on 6th June 1878, to Jessie McKie, who had been born at Auchenshinnoch, Dalry, on 3rd May 1848, the daughter of Thomas McKie and his wife Joan Clark. At the time of their marriage, William was described as a shepherd, living at Knockreoch, Kells, which had been his address at the tine of the 1871 Census. At the time of the 1881 Census, William and Jessie were at

Dundeugh, Carsphairn, where he was a shepherd. By the time of the 1891 Census they were at Auchengruith, Sanquhar. Judging by the birthplaces of their children, they were in Muirkirk, Ayrshire, in 1884, in Kirkconnel, Dumfriesshire, m 1886, and had been in Sanquhar since 1888. Jessie died at Stroanpatrick, Dalry, on 21st August 1922, aged 74. Her Death Certificate gave the cause of death as Cerebral Haemorrhage. According to her grandson William Dick, she took a stroke while milking the coo. William died at Stroanpatrick, Dalry, on 24th November 1923, aged 75. His Death Certificate gave the causes of death as paraplegia, due to haemorrhage in spinal cord, 8 years, bedsores and exhaustion. According to William Dick, his grandfather broke his back when a dyke collapsed as he was climbing over it. William Hunter and Jessie had seven children:

- vi. Joan Clerk, born in Sanquhar, on 25th November 1888.
- vii. Agnes, born at Auchengruith Cottage. Sanguhar, on 25th May 1894.
- g. Isabella. born in Carsphairn on 9th October 1849 and baptised on 15th. She had a son :
 - i. John Hunter. born in Carsphairn on 13th June 1870, living with his grandmother at Knowehead at the times of the 1871 and 1881 Censuses when he was described as John H. Henderson. On 12th November 1897 John, who was a shepherd, described as the son of Isabella Hunter, with his reputed father being John Henderson, a ploughman, was married in Troqueer to Jemima Armstrong, who had been born about 1868. the daughter of George Armstrong, a ploughman, and his wife Elizabeth Scott. Jemima died at Heathfield, Holywood. on 27th June 1906. They had a daughter:
 - A. Elizabeth Scott, born in Troqueer on 11th December 1897.

Isabella was married in Carsphairn on 13th June 1873 to James Good, described as a lead miner, who had been born in Carsphairn on 6th September 1845, the son of James Good, a labourer, and his wife Jane McMillan. James died in Ayr on 13th September 1910, and Isabella died there on 21st October 1923.

- h. Thomas, born in Carsphairn on 3rd October 1851 and baptised on 22nd. He was married in Dalry on 23rd May 1879 to Mary Thompson, who had been born in Kirkmichael about 1856, the daughter of John Thompson, a shepherd, and his wile Mary Kerr.
- i. Alexander, born in Carsphairn on 16th April 1854 and baptised on 9th May. He was married in Dalry on 12th June 1885 to Agnes Burnside, who had been born in Dalry about 1864, the daughter of Thomas Burnside, a gamekeeper, and his wife Jane Forest.
- j. Samuel, born in Carsphairn on 7th March 1856. Samuel was working as a groom at Clerkhill Farm, Eskdalemuir, at the time of the 1881 Census. He was a shepherd on the same farm when he was married, on 13th June 1884, at Heatherwick, in the parish of Hutton, to Annie Beattie, who had been born about 1856, the daughter of John Beattie, a shepherd, and his wife Janet Anderson. Thereafter there is no mention of the couple in Scotland, in the following censuses or statutory registrations, aid it must be assumed that they left the country.
