








GALA CHAIRMAN - DEREK MCCALLUM'S WELCOME

RIDING OF THE MARCHES 2008

The 5th annual Riding of the Marches ceremony will take place on the evening of Sunday 3rd August starting at 6.15pm. The event restarted in 2004 and it re enacts the granting of the rights of a Burgh Barony to Gatehouse of Fleet in 1795. The main principals in this years event are Fleet Lad ANDY DALE, Fleet Lass WENDY CLARK and the Standard Bearer TOM BROWN. In the past the Fleet Lad would have been a senior cavalry officer whose role would be to check the boundaries as specified in the Charter. This is where the term 'Riding of the Marches' originates. In the olden days the boundaries would be 'stobbed' or marked out by means of a small wooden stake driven into the edges of the boundary and they would be all checked to make sure no one was encroaching on the area. The Burgh Standard is taken around as a symbol of the Burgh. The cavalcade winds its way around the streets of Gatehouse of Fleet, as it would be impossible to cover the whole area in the space of an evening! The traditional ' stirrup cup' is taken at various hostelries around the town and a wreath is laid at the War Memorial, to honour the Dead of the two Wars. At the end of the Ride the Standard is handed back for safe keeping to the senior town official ie the Provost. The cavalcade or followers were 'back up' to the principals in case they met with any problems with marauders! The traditional Marches seems to be very much a South west of Scotland and the Borders event, with most of the larger towns carrying out the same re enactment. A traditional 'Marches Ball' will be held on Saturday 27th September 2008 at the Murray Arms Hotel culminating in the traditional 'Parade of Sashes', where the principals past and present from neighbouring towns parade in front of the guests. Tickets for this event are available to everyone —see advertisement on page 38 of this brochure

This 9-hole course is situated on the Laurieston Road, within walking distance of Gatehouse. Imaginatively laid out in 1921, the course is a good test of a player's golfing skills all the year. Whilst the good golfers enjoy the challenge the course presents, it is also the type of course that can be played and enjoyed by any standard of golfer, including beginners and juniors. From the clubhouse, and playing the first hole, impressions are of a very hilly course, but visitors should not be put off, as the next seven holes are more on a level, before playing the dramatic short 9th hole back to the clubhouse. The views alone are worth the visit, as in one direction beautiful hills and glens can be seen, whilst in the other the view over Gatehouse itself to Wigtown Bay and the Isle of Man is rather special. Visitors are made most welcome, and the club attracts golfers from all parts of the United Kingdom as well as overseas. Most people having played the course once, cannot wait to arrange a return visit, such is the enjoyment and pleasure a game of golf at Gatehouse can give you. The green fees for the 2008 season are £15 per day (including weekends) for adults and £8 for juniors (under 18). There is no limit to how many holes you can play in the day, so with the long summer days, plenty of golf can be played. The course is reserved most Sunday mornings until approximately 12 noon for club competitions for members, but apart from that time, visitors are very welcome.
