

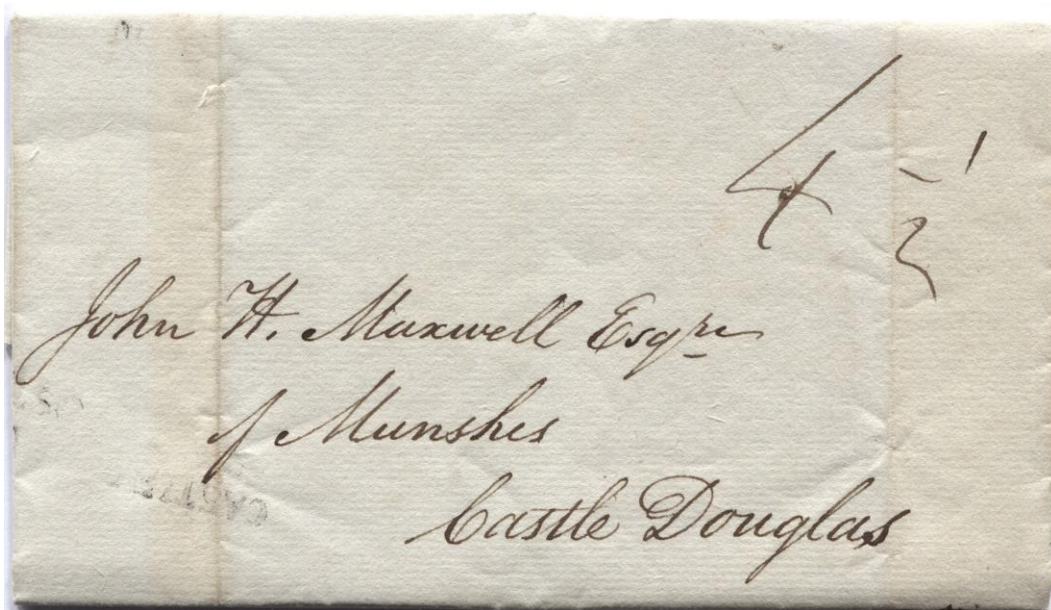

Postal charge 4½d.

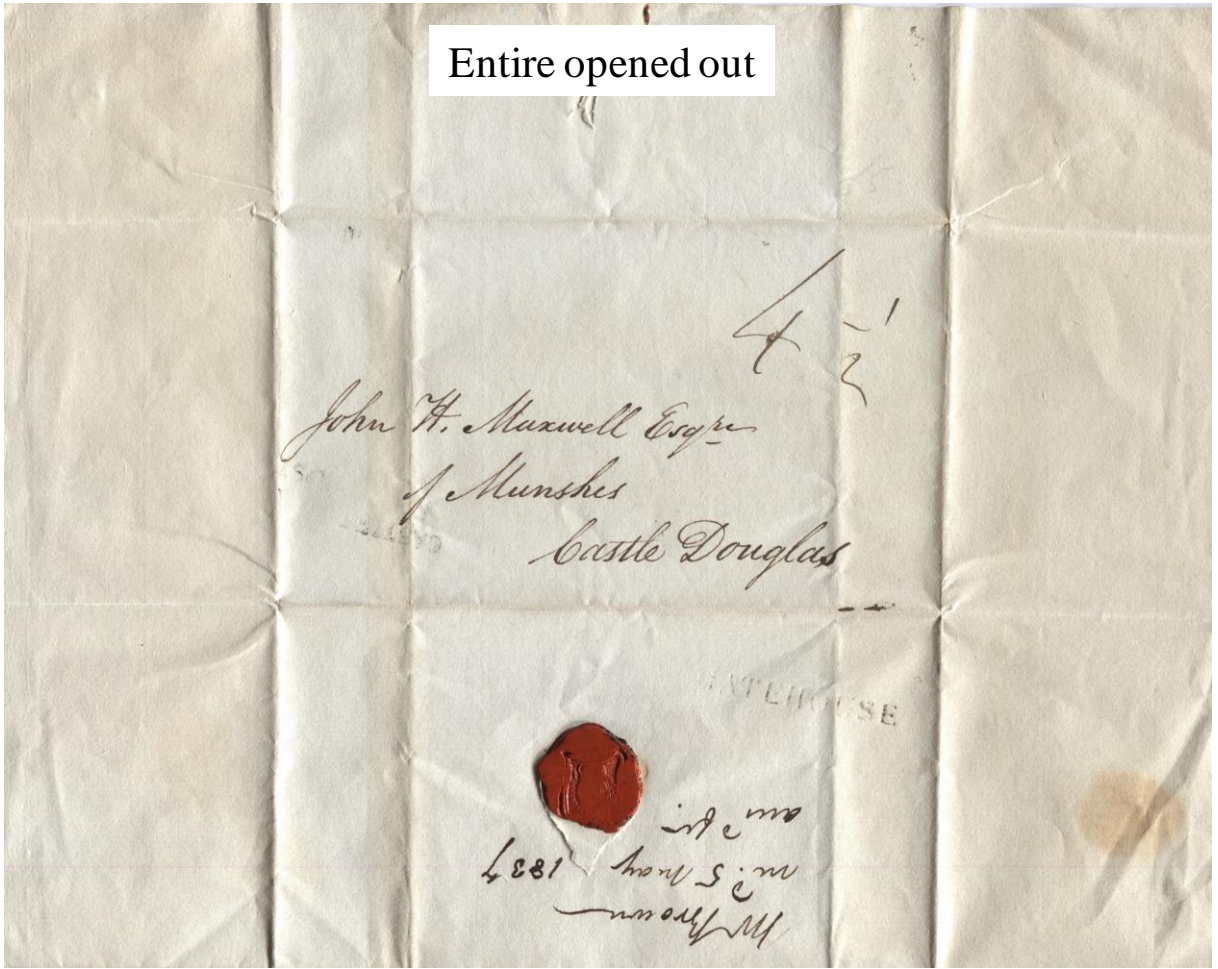

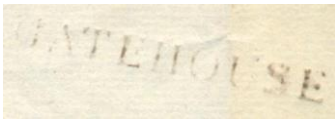

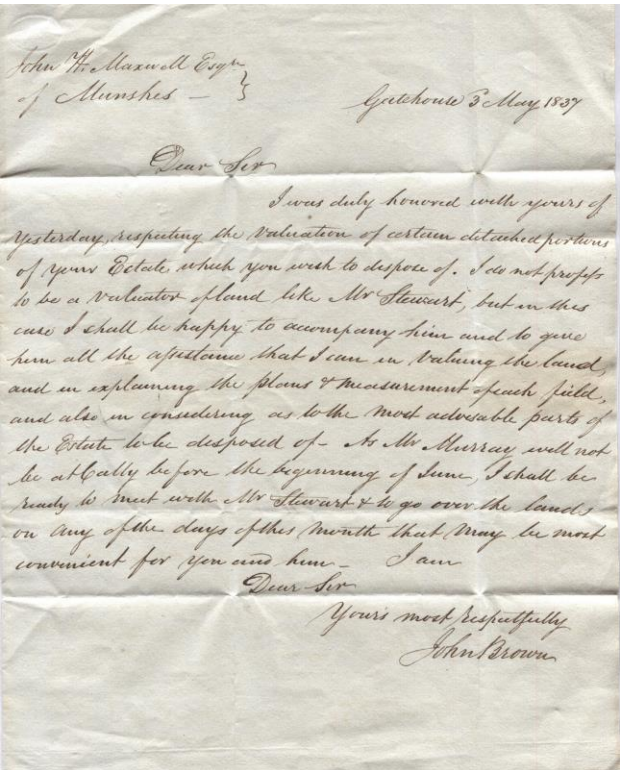
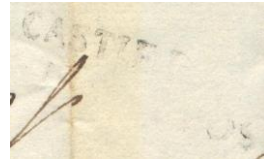
Entire opened out

Dear Sir,

I was duly honoured with yours of yesterday, respecting the valuation of certain detached portions of your Estate which you wish to dispose of.
