



Anwoth Old Kirk Gravestone No.194

*Stone surrounded by wall* — Erected by Robert Hannay, Esq., of Rusko in memory of his father Robert Hannay of Rusko who died Feb<sup>y</sup> 24<sup>th</sup> 1836 aged 77 years. Also of his daughter Janet Kerr who died June 25<sup>th</sup> 1843 aged 5 years and 9 months. Here rest also the remains of the first above named Robert Hannay Esq<sup>r</sup>. of Rusko who died at Springfield, Ulverston on the 30<sup>th</sup> Sep<sup>t</sup> 1874 in the 68 year of his age. “The mercy of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him”. Also Bridget his widow who died at Daltongate House, Ulverston 20<sup>th</sup> April 1879 aged 70 years. “She is not dead but sleepeth” “the weary are at rest”.
