Erected by William McMurray in memory of his father Nathan McMurray, Smith & Bellhanger who died at Gatehouse 7 Feb 1847 aged 37 years. Also Eliza Hyslop wife of William McMurray who died at Manchester 18 March 1870 aged 33 years. And of their children, Maggie, Robert, Agnes & John who died young. Also Agnes third daughter of William McMurray and Janet McKean who died at Gatehouse 25 Aug 1878 aged 6 weeks. Also Nathan McMurray eldest son of William McMurray who died at Wigtown on 3 Sep 1882 aged 22 years and was interred in Wigtown Churchyard. "Not dead but sleepeth".
