Sacred to the memory of Marion Jane daughter of Rev T. Johnstone, Minister of Anwoth who died on the 13th July 1847 aged 2 years. Luke XVIII.16.17. Also of Helen his daughter who died in infancy, A.D. 1849. Also of Margaret Adamson his wife who died 4 November 1859 aged 38 years. Also of his eldest daughter Anne Harriet wife of Rev W. McM. Black, Minister of St Marks Church, Montreal who died there 21st Oct 1871 aged 29 years.

*Reverse* - Also in memory of Robert Adamson Johnstone his younger son who died at Montreal, Canada 24<sup>th</sup> Nov 1879 aged 28 years. "He that soweth to the spirit, shall of the spirit reap life everlasting". Gal 6.8. Also of Thomas Johnstone his elder son who died at Silloth, Cumberland 11th April 1900 aged 53 years, and is buried there.

*Side* - Also in memory of the Rev<sup>d</sup> Thomas Johnstone, Minister of Anwoth from March 28th 1839 when he was ordained till June 11th 1875 when he died aged 60 years. "Your fathers, where are they? And the prophets do they live forever?" Zechariah 1.5. Also in loving memory of Janet Wilson eldest daughter of the Rev<sup>d</sup> Thomas Johnstone and widow of the late Surgeon General David Cullen of Cheltenham died 12th August 1922. Also Lilias Johnstone his youngest daughter who died at Kippford 10th April 1934 aged 78 years.
