

In loving memory of the Rev. William Macmillan Black, founder and for ten years Minister of St Mark's Church, Montreal and for almost twenty six years Minister of this Parish: born Montreal 12 Dec 1839 where he died 16 Dec 1901 and is buried there in Mount Royal Cemetery. And of Annie Harriet Johnstone his first wife who died at Montreal 21 October 1871. And of Margaret Johnstone their eldest daughter born Anwoth June 1869 died in Edinburgh February 1899. John Greenshields their second son born Montreal Sept 1867 died in Edinburgh April 1903. Edward their eldest son born in Montreal Oct 1865 died Sept 1904 at Beconsfield, Bucks where he is buried. And of his family by his second wife William Macmillan their eldest son, Capt. and Adjut. 58 Vaughan's Rifles, F.F. Indian Army born 12 Sept 1883 fell in action near Festubert 31 Oct 1914, buried at Bethune, France. And of Amy, his second wife, eldest daughter of J.J. Greenshields of Singapore, born there 1856, died at Old Colyn, 8 May 1920. Anwoth Manse was her home from 1889 to 1902 and she now sleeps here. "Blessed are the pure in heart". And of Elizabeth McCulloch their second daughter born at Anwoth Nov.1888, died at Torquay 8 Nov 1921 and is laid to rest here. R.I.P.
