In memory of David Clark, F.E.I.S. for 45 years teacher in Fleetside School, Gatehouse who died 29 Spottiswoode Street, Edinburgh 8<sup>th</sup> Feby 1918 aged 76 years. Wilfrid Thomas his third son who died at Fleetside Schoolhouse 9<sup>th</sup> Dec 1894 aged 6 months. Cecil his youngest son who died at 29 Spottiswoode, Edinburgh 20<sup>th</sup> April 1916 aged 16 years. Mary sister of the above David Clark who died at Montrose 6<sup>th</sup> Feb<sup>y</sup> 1915 aged 85 years. Also in memory of Lieut. William Park, D.L.I. son-in-law of the above David Clark who was killed at Epehy in France 21<sup>st</sup> March 1918 aged 32 years. Also Jane Duncan wife of David Clark who died at Edinburgh 7<sup>th</sup> Aug 1944 aged 82 years. John J. Clark their second son died at Edinburgh 20<sup>th</sup> Jan<sup>y</sup> 1940 aged 47 years. David W. Clark their eldest son died at Edinburgh 25<sup>th</sup> Aug 1943 aged 52. Mollie their daughter, wife of 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieut. W. Park died 27<sup>th</sup> March 1969 aged 79.
