HairNV is no.34, Bobbin Guest House is no. 36

Both buildings would have originally been in single ownership.

HairNV now occupies the ground floor of no.34 High Street. The hairdressers has previously been used as a butchers shop, run by the McMichael and the Cochrane families. The Bobbin Guest House includes the remainder of nos.34 & 36 including all of the garden. It is not clear for how long this property split has been in its current form.

The 1841 census for High St. starts with family 'Front Street 6' who lived at 2 High St. The enumerator then listed families in sequence until the above families who probably lived at 34/36 High St, before he crossed over the road and headed back east along High Street. After Digby Street and Catherine Street, he then continued west along High St from the Well Entry (no.38, family 'Front Street 47') to Fleetvale before crossing the road again to Laurelbank and heading east back up to Digby St.
