

# Barrington-Browne

William Ellis

1908 - 1985

## His Life

**William Ellis Barrington Browne** was born 17th December 1908 in Kensington, London to Henry Needham Browne (b.1876 London d.1930 England) and Kate Isabel Ellis (b.1870 Liverpool d.1928 Lewes, Sussex). In 1901 Liverpool census William's father-to-be Henry was an **illustrative artist**.

1911 Kensington census: William Browne aged 2, born Kensington with mother Kate I. Browne (37, b.Liverpool) and 4 siblings all born in Liverpool. Father, Henry, was in Hove, Sussex (age 34, married with 5 children, an artist/painter) with his mother Louisa Pilham-Clinton.

1936 William married at Charlton Kings, Gloucestershire to Cecilia Muriel Hargreaves Elwas. Cecilia was born in Edinburgh in 1904 and died in Cheltenham in 1956.

1958 William married Joan Augusta Parsons (b.1915) at Westminster, London. Joan died in January 1972 at Cirencester.

1972 William married for a third time to Rosemary Nunneley at Cirencester, Gloucestershire.

1985 William died 7th December 1985 Chesterton House, Cirencester.

## His work

Barrington-Browne liked to paint scenes in the wild, from river fishing to red deer stags in the mountains.

We don't know when he came to Gatehouse but he clearly painted the scene on the Fleet below.


