Her Life

Vivien K Chapman was born in 1925 at Blandford, Dorset.

Parents Kyrle A S Chapman and Katherine G M Lonsdale who married in 1920 at Wimborne, Dorset Vivien attended Edinburgh College of Art in the 1940s.

In 1947 she married Leszek-tadeusk Muszynski at Hampstead, London, they had a son Alec.

In 1955 Vivien Muszynski was living in Edinburgh.

In 1960 she married Thomas Kinmont Redpath at Haymarket, Edinburgh.

Thomas Redpath was an artist and art teacher - known as Kim, He was a nephew of the artist Anne Redpath. He studied at Edinburgh College of Art.

In the early 1960s Thomas taught at Kilquanity School near Castle Douglas and then at the school at St John's Town of Dalry. The family lived at Dalry and Balmaclellan Vivien was his second wife. They later divorced.

Vivien moved to Gatehouse and lived at the Old Schoolhouse, Anwoth in the 1960s. She moved to England in 1974.
