By 2012 No.1 & No.3 Ann Street owned separately.

The Crosbie family lived at no.1 Ann Street from at least 1901 until 1971. For some if not most of this time the Crosbie's also occupied no.3 Ann Street.

Part of No.3 was used as an office for the Crosbie garage business, which at that time was in the Old Posting Stables opposite the Murray Arms.

In the later 20th Century the building was used as a laundry and then as a store for the Murray Arms Hotel.

It has now been purchased as a dwelling and is being renovated and extended (September 2014).
