1783 Part of Alexander Lillie's feu with the Bay Horse (No.9 Ann Street) until 1971.

Property deeds seem to indicate that Nos. 7 & 9 Ann Street were in common ownership for nearly 200 years. Throughout the census availability period (1841 to 1911) No.9 was a business, either as a hotel or as a joiner's workshop. It seems that the occupants of No.7 were often associated with the business at No.9.
