## **Birtwhistle Street – West View**

From the time they were first feued (in 1785) until 1947, all the properties on the north side of Birtwhistle Street were under single ownership. The owner did change from time to time, but ownership covered all the houses on that side of the street.

The censuses alone do not provide sufficient information to be sure of who lived in what house before the 1881 census.

Ownership up to 1947 is contained in a separate file ("Birtwhistle St.N to 1947"), and all recorded occupants of Birtwhistle Street in the first 4 censuses are also listed separately ("Birtwhistle St.N census 1841" to Birtwhistle St.N census 1871")..

John Henderson died in 1911. His youngest son, also named John but known as Jack, was born at Westview 2 months after his death. By 1914 widow Margaret Henderson and her family had moved to Catherine Street.

In 1923, Margaret Henderson and all the rest of her family emigrated to New Zealand to join her son Ivan who had emigrated there in 1920. Young Jack remained in Gatehouse, being cared for by members of the Henderson family.

In later life Jack and his wife Chrissie lived in East View - at the other end of Birtwhistle Street. The story of Jack Henderson, gamekeeper can be found at 'Who Did What' - 'Kenspeckle Folk'.

Catherine Miller, spinster.

occupied by John Miller, retired.

1960-61 Valuation Roll: 23 Birtwhistle Street, West View, is owned

and occupied by Margaret W Muir.

1974-75 Valuation Roll: 23 Birtwhistle Street, West View, is owned and

occupied by Mrs Margaret W Muir.
