East View [Castramont Road]

From the time the last was first feued (in 1785) until 1947, all the properties on the north side of Birtwhistle Street were under single ownership. The owner did change from time to time, but ownership covered all the houses on that side of the street.

The censuses alone do not provide sufficient information to be sure of who lived in what house before the 1881 census.

Ownership up to 1947 is contained in a separate file ("Birtwhistle St.N to 1947"), and all recorded occupants of Birtwhistle Street in the first 4 censuses are also listed separately ("Birtwhistle St.N census 1841" to Birtwhistle St.N census 1871")..


East View was probably referred to as No.1 Birtwhistle Street in the 1881 census, and was unoccupied.

Note from Jack Henderson

Gatehouse bricks were used in building many local houses. The south wall of East View was built with Gatehouse bricks, this wall having been discovered, and left intact, when renovations were carried out by the late Tom McGaw's father.

These renovations also uncovered a fine brick-built bakers oven and a hatch opening onto Birtwhistle St. An old fireplace was found in the lobby at the side door into East View. This still remains but is plastered over.
