1834	Sold by William Hannah to William Munro, innkeeper.

William Munro was innkeeper at the Blue Bell Inn which later became 10 Catherine Street.

William died in 1846, and by 1851 there was a new innkeeper, and we believe his wife Jane moved across the road.
