John Denniston, retired bookseller, 27 High Street, Kirkcudbright, owned two houses in Catherine Street. One was occupied by Jane Manson, widow and the other was occupied by James Fitzpatrick, labourer.

1915 Sold by trustees of James Denniston sometime booksellers and stationers, Kirkcudbright to John McNeil.

1921-22 Girthon Valuation Roll:

Janet McNeil, widow owned 4 houses in Catherine Street. She occupied one herself and the tenants of the others were William N Worral (labourer), Elizabeth Hay (domestic servant), and Robert Marshall (labourer).

1930-31 Girthon Valuation Roll:

Janet McNeil, widow owned 4 houses in Catherine Street. She occupied one herself and the tenants of the others were William N Worral (labourer), Elizabeth Hay (domestic servant), and Mary Jane Wilson.

1936 Sold by John McNeil to Edith and Josephine Cross.

1940-41 Girthon Valuation Roll:

James McNeil, seemingly owned 2 houses at 48 Catherine Street. One of these was condemned and the other was occupied by Elizabeth Hay, spinster, so James McNeil probably lived elsewhere. Richard Lillie was the agent.
