Walker (35), John Gardiner's heirs (33), William Ramage (31 & 29), John Kirkpatrick's heirs (27) and James Maben (25).

The names listed as owning adjacent gardens are those who own property in Catherine Street from the corner of Digby Street heading east.

No.27 was owned by Thomas Kirkpatrick, son of James Kirkpatrick, but the name listed above is John Kirkpatrick.
