The names listed as owning adjacent gardens are those who own property in Catherine Street from the corner of Digby Street heading east.

James & Martha Hornsby lived at 2-4 High Street in 1861.

1874 James Hornsby bought from Dorothy Long the plot on which a house was later built between Swan Street and Back Street. The document refers to feus of James Hornsby, James Walker, the heirs of William Carson and partly the feu of Grace and Mary Walker

Dorothy Long owned the plot on which the Swan Street houses were built. The above transaction may have involved the land on which Glenavon was subsequently built.
