#### Nos. 2 to 10 Catherine Street

1783	All feued to John McCoskrie, postmaster in Gatehouse, measuring 185 ft along the street
1788 ?	Sold to William Hannay of Bargaly
1823	New charter to William McNish
1824	Sold to Alexander Cairns, joiner
1833	Passed to Nicholas McNish, wife of Alexander Cairns
1854	Title of Christina McNish or McClure
1854	<i>The 1854 map suggests that nos 2 &amp; 4 Back Street were small detached properties whilst nos. 6, 8 &amp; 10 were a terrace of houses.</i>

#### Nos.4 & 6

1866	Sold to Robert McMicken
1880	Sold to James and Robert Henry ?
1881	Occupied by James Henry
1950	Nos. 4 & 6 sold by Herbert Charles Henry to Henry Patterson.

#### No.6

1950	plot 30 ft 6 inches sold by Henry Patterson to Arthur Hunter.
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**1950-51 Girthon Valuation Roll :** Workshop and wood-yard on Catherine Street (No.6) was owned by Henry Patterson and tenanted by A Hunter, joiner.

**1960-61 Girthon Valuation Roll :** Arthur J Hunter, joiner, Drumaber owned a garage at 6 Catherine Street, and owned and occupied a workshop & woodyard in Catherine Street.

c.1974	Arthur Hunter built a house on the site of the old workshop.
1976	Title of Mrs Agnes Wyse or Hunter
1984	Sold to Desmond and Audrey Wright
c.1997	Present owners [Cotton]
