## 8 Catherine Street – "The White House"



### Chronology of Ownership & Occupancy

#### Nos. 2 to 10 Catherine Street

1783 Land feued to John McCoskrie, postmaster in Gatehouse .

- 1866 Nos. 2 to 8 sold by estate of Christina McNish to Robert McMiken, , High Creoch and his wife Grace Gemmill.No. 10 sold to Rev John Grogan , RC priest Kirkcudbright
- 1880 Nos. 4 & 6 probably sold to James and Robert Henry.
- **1881** Grace Gemmell or McMicken sold **No.2** to Samuel Williamson, merchant, Liverpool. At that time Joseph Tait, painter occupied no.2.

Grace Gemmell must have retained **No.8** as she sold this to T H McGaw in 1896.

#### 1851 Girthon Census – Examination of census returns suggests that this property was unoccupied in 1851

1854	Title of Christina McNish or McClure Note that in 1833 ownership had passed to Nicholas McNish from her husband Alexander Cairns.
	Was Christina a sister of Nicholas who married someone with surname McClure ?
1854	The 1854 map suggests that nos 2 & 4 Back Street were small detached properties whilst nos. 6, 8 & 10 were a terrace of houses.

# **1859-60 Girthon Valuation Roll :**Mrs Christina McClure, owned a house, shop, garden and backhouse that was<br/>occupied by James Douglas, saddler. She also owned 2 houses with gardens, one<br/>occupied by Charles James McClure and the other by Miss Elizabeth Wright. She<br/>also owned a property for which annual rent was <£4, so occupants were not<br/>identified.
