In 1851, the enumerator seems to have entered the above 3 families as living in the same building with the implication that next door (26) might have been empty. Because 24 & 26 were under single ownership, we believe that maybe the Turner family lived at 24 Catherine Street, whilst the Stott & Reid families could have lived at no.26.

1858 Jane Carnochan died in Girthon aged 66.

with annual rent <£4, somewhere in Gatehouse.
