54 & 56 Catherine Street

54 & 56 Catherine Street remained under single ownership until T H McGaw, junior, inherited in 1906. Some time later he sold no.56 to Jessie Chesney, but paperwork and dates have been lost. A revised sale of no.56 to Jane McMinn or Samways was facilitated in 1926, and no.54 was sold to Samuel Black Corrie in 1927.

Between Digby Street and Victoria Street there would have been four single storey and four 2-storey buildings. The enumerator referred to only 7 buildings and there were no empty properties so we think the above families would have lived in both 54 & 56 Catherine Street, which were treated as a single building.

In 1911, the enumerator seems to have listed the last 9 properties at the west end of the south side of Catherine Street starting at the corner of Digby Street. The above family occupy the last house in Catherine Street, at the corner of Victoria Street.

Janet Stewart, wife of Charles Edward Stewart, postman, 90 Cricklewood Lane, London NW, owned a house in Catherine Street that was occupied by James C Anderson, blacksmith.

The above 2 records go together, but this property (and No.54) belonged to T H McGaw jnr.

Unless McGaw sold to Chesney and then Chesney sold to Stewart.But Chesney owned the property per 1930-31 VR and Samways owned it by the 1940-41 VR.
